1. Caption Writing Competition:

The competition is conducted by **NSS ASSOCIATION**

Rules:

- It is an individual event.
- All the participants will have to caption a single photography.
- Caption the picture in the best 10-15 words.
- Participants can write the caption only in English.
- The submission should not contain any offensive contents.
- **Judgment criteria:**
 - **Originality**
 - **Creativity**
 - **Appropriateness**
- **Name of the participant with register number, class and batch must be mentioned.**
- The caption should be mailed to nsssapuc@gmail.com with student name and complete register number, failing which the entry will be disqualified.
- **Last date to submit: 11th June 2020**
- Judges decision is final.

2. Digital Collage Making Competition:

The competition is conducted by **PHOTOGRAPHY ASSOCIATION**

Theme - Hope amidst Corona crisis worldwide

Rules:

- An individual competition
- Participant must prepare a digital collage that uses virtual images from different sources, pieced and layered together into one final assembled image on the given theme.
- **Judgment criteria -**
 - **Creativity**
 - **Expression of theme**
 - **Technical execution**

3. Short documentary making competition:

Rules:

4. NEWS FLASH (News bulletin):

Theme: Time for Humanity and Earth to heal.

Rules:

- It is an individual event.
- Newsflash should be formatted and typed only in English (500 to 1000 words).
- The news bulletin can be supplemented with pictures (photographs). Maximum of 3 pictures are allowed.
- **Judgment is based on Creativity, Content and Presentation.**
- Name of the participant with register number, class and batch must be mentioned.
- The pdf should be mailed to reportersclubsapuc@gmail.com with student name and complete register number, failing which the entry will be disqualified.
- **Last date to submit: 11th June 2020**
- Judges decision is final.

5. Essay writing competition:

The competition is conducted by **SANSKRIT ASSOCIATION**

Rules:

- Individual event.
- Essay should be written in Sanskrit
- Maximum of 250 words

7. Creating Symphony of instrument or instruments competition:

Description: Wind instruments are typically grouped into two families: Brass instruments (horns, trumpets, trombones, euphoniums, and tubas) Woodwind instruments (recorders, flutes, oboes, clarinets, saxophones, and bassoons etc)

Rules:

- It's an individual competition.

- It should be word-processed preferably using Microsoft Word, with 1.5 spacing, with each page numbered, and with the title on the top of each page.
- Do not include any pictures or other illustrations.
- The participant's name and class should be on the bottom of the last page
- References - books, articles or online sources that are cited should be listed at the end.
- It should be an original piece of work (by giving more focus on your ideas or thoughts to deal with this topic) .It should be written in the Participant's own words and not copied from any books, articles, or from the internet.
- **You will be judged on concept, creativity and realistic approach.**
